1. Course fees

2. Payment options

I accept the following payments:

3. Cancellation policy

KIDS BALLET I would be sad to see someone leave. But if your child wishes to discontinue a notice of 8 weeks must be given in writing. You can fill in a **Cancellation Form** on the website: www.balletandmore.ch/cancel. Fees will still be due even if your child is unable to attend class until the completion of the notice period.

BABY BALLET & CONTAKIDS Unfortunately the cancellation policy is not applicable on the short courses.

TRIAL MONTH KIDS BALLET

A Trial Month can be purchased once and consists of 4 consecutive lessons. After this month you can enroll your child for the Kids Ballet classes or cancel without notice period.

CANCELLED CLASSES In case of sickness (teacher) and/or other unforeseeable emergencies on my side, I reserve the right to cancel 5% of classes without compensation. In case I have to cancel several classes you will receive make up classes in return.

For any **missed classes** due to sickness or any other reason of the student or the parent, I offer make up classes by joining an existing class. In case you like to make use of it, call or email me beforehand.

In case of **injury**, you must notify me immediately if your child can no longer participate (or for an extended time period) in my classes.

6. Liability

Ballet & more is not liable for personal injury or any loss or damage of personal property, whilst on the premises. Ballet & more will aim to provide a safe learning environment to reduce risk of injury. It should be recognized by all students, parents/guardians that dance by its very nature carries a risk of injury or accident.

Ballet & more provides qualified dance teachers, who actively promote safe dance practice. This being the case, it should be realized that injuries do occur from time to time and students must accept this element of risk. It is the student's parents/guardians responsibility to notify their teacher in the event of injury/medical conditions or disabilities prior to class. At the commencement of each class, it is the student's or students/parents or guardians responsibility to inform their teacher of any injury which is being treated or may be of concern. All dancers are required to have the correct shoes for class. I will not be liable for any injuries caused, due to the lack of inappropriate footwear.

Regular weekly class attendance is vital for students to develop and keep up with the syllabus for the year. Students must be punctual to ensure they receive a complete warm up.

Ballet & more is not liable for any thefts in the dressing room and inside the studio. It is advisable to leave no valuables.

SICKNESS

- If your child is unwell, please do not send them to class until fully recovered. This is to ensure the well being of all students and staff.
- You can use make up classes for missed classes. In case you like to make use of it, call or email me beforehand.

7. Uniform

I believe that wearing uniforms give students a sense of belonging to the Ballet & more family as well as creating an identity for my studio in the greater community. Uniforms are compulsory for Kids Ballet classes from age 4.

The uniforms also

- Encourage discipline
- Help students resist peer pressure to buy stylish clothes for class
- Help identify non-students in the studio
- Diminish economic and social barriers between students
- Increase a sense of belonging and school pride
- Improve attendance
